COTTON GIN POWER
RATES 106

Effective Date: May 10, 2019

APPLICABLE:

For power service in a cotton gin. All service will be supplied through one kilowatt-hour meter, at one point of delivery.

Service is for the exclusive use of the Customer and is not to be resold or shared with others. Not applicable to standby or supplemental service.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE:

Three-phase, 60 cycles, at one standard nominal voltage required by the Customer, as described in Utilities' Standards for Electrical Installations. The Utilities will furnish transformation equipment for one utilization voltage only.

MONTHLY RATE:

Customer Charge: 20.32

Energy Charge:

First 2,000 kWh per month	@	\$0.1341 per kWh
Next 8,000 kWh per month	@	\$0.1176 per kWh
All additional kWh per month	@	\$0.0984 per kWh

ADJUSTMENTS:

The amount computed at the above Monthly Rate shall be adjusted plus or minus by an amount calculated in accordance with the formula specified in the Utilities' Power Cost Adjustment Clause which is incorporated by reference as a part of this rate schedule.

Second- Plus the applicable proportionate part of any directly allocable tax, impost or assessment imposed or levied by any government authority, which is assessed or levied against the Utilities or directly affects the Utilities' cost of operation and which the Utilities is legally obligated to pay on the basis of meters, customers, or rates of, or revenue from electric power and energy or service sold, or on the volume of the energy generated, transported, purchased for sale, or sold, or on any other basis where direct allocation is possible.

Third – If the power factor at point of measurement is found to be less than 85%, load measurement may also be made by kVA meter, in which case, one kVA as registered will be considered as .85 kW, but not less than the actual kW. If the instantaneous load exceeds the highest average fifteen-minute load by an unusual amount, such instantaneous load may be taken as the load used for billing.

PAYMENT:

Bills are due and payable each month upon presentation. If a bill is not paid within fifteen days from the date thereof, Utilities have the right to suspend service.

RESERVATION:

The Greenwood Utilities Commission reserves the right to change this rate at any time it may deem necessary, and service is subject to other Utilities' policies as are applicable.
