GENERAL LIGHTING AND POWER  
RATES 104-105

Effective Date: May 10, 2019

APPLICATION:

To all electric service for which no specific schedule is provided, supplied at one point of delivery and measured through one kilowatt-hour meter.

Not applicable for resale or for temporary, supplementary, standby, or shared services.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE:

Single or three-phase, 60 cycles, at one standard nominal voltage.

MONTHLY RATE:

Customer Charge:

Single-Phase Service	\$10.00
Three-Phase Service	\$13.29

Energy Charge:

First 300 kWh per month	@	\$0.1316 per kWh
Next 550 kWh per month*	@	\$0.1153 per kWh
Next 7,000 kWh per month	@	\$0.0845 per kWh
All additional kWh per month	@	\$0.0794 per kWh

Except those in excess of the greater of 60,000 kWh or 300 kWh per kW of measured demand @ \$0.0765 per kWh.

\*When the kW of measured load is above 6 kW, the \$0.1153 per kWh is increased at the rate of:

120 kWh per kW for the first 19 kW over 6 kW
80 kWh per kW for the next 75 kW
72 kWh per kW for all additional kWh.

MINIMUM BILL:

The monthly minimum charge shall be the customer charge or such amount as may be required for line extension customers to justify the additional investment necessary to provide service and to cover the cost of rendering service.

### ADJUSTMENTS:

The amount computed at the above Monthly Rate shall be adjusted plus or minus by an amount calculated in accordance with the formula specified in the Utilities' Power Cost Adjustment Clause which is incorporated by reference as a part of this rate schedule.

Second- Plus the applicable proportionate part of any directly allocable tax, impost or assessment imposed or levied by any government authority, which is assessed or levied against the Utilities or directly affects the Utilities' cost of operation and which the Utilities is legally obligated to pay on the basis of meters, customers, or rates of, or revenue from electric power and energy or service sold, or on the volume of the energy generated, transported, purchased for sale, or sold, or on any other basis where direct allocation is possible.

### MEASURED LOAD:

The average kW supplied during the 15-minute period of greatest use during the current month, but not less than the higher of: (1) the minimum kW specified in the Agreement for Electric Service, of (2) one-third of the Capacity Requirement.

Load measurement, at Utilities' option may be made by kVA or thermal type ampere meter, in which case one kVA will be considered equivalent to one kW.

If the power factor at point of measurement is found to be less than 85%, demand measurement may be made by kVA demand meter, in which case, one kVA as registered will be considered as .85 kW, but not less than the actual kW. If the instantaneous load exceeds the highest average 15-minute load by an unusual amount, such instantaneous load may be taken as the demand used for billing.

### CAPACITY REQUIREMENTS:

The highest kW of Measured Load established during the preceding eleven months, or the maximum kW specified in the Agreement for Electric Service, whichever is the greatest. In the event the instantaneous of Customer's installation exceeds the Measured Load by more than fifty percent, such instantaneous load may be taken as the Capacity requirement.

### PAYMENT:

Bills are due and payable each month upon presentation. If a bill is not paid within fifteen days from the date thereof, Utilities have the right to suspend service.

### RESERVATION:

The Greenwood Utilities Commission reserves the right to change this rate at any time it may deem necessary, and service is subject to compliance with Service Rules and Regulations and other Utilities' policies as are applicable.
