ELECTRIC - RESIDENTIAL
RATES 100-101

Effective Date: May 10, 2019

APPLICATION:

For residential service to private residences or individual family apartments, and on farms with individual motor loads not larger than ten horsepower, supplied through one meter.

Where dwellings occupied by more than one family are served through one meter, the customer charge and the kWh in each block of the Monthly Rate will be multiplied by the number of families served. Service is for the use of the Customer and may not otherwise be shared and may not be resold to others.

When a portion of a residence is used for other than residential purposes as evidenced by the requirement of a privilege license, the appropriate non-residential service schedule will be applied.

Not applicable to standby, shared, temporary, resale or supplementary service.

MONTHLY RATE:

Customer Charge:

Single-Phase Service	\$21.00
Three-Phase Service	\$21.19

Energy Charge:

First 200 kWh per month	@	\$.0998 per kWh
Next 300 kWh per month	@	.0871 per kWh
All additional kWh per month	@	.0788 per kWh

MINIMUM BILL:

The monthly minimum charge shall be the customer charge or such amount as may be required for line extension customers to justify the additional investment necessary to provide service and to cover the cost of rendering service.

THREE-PHASE SERVICE:

Three-phase service is available only where Utilities has facilities installed for such service or where Customer complies with Utilities' other requirements toward installation of such facilities as can be installed for that purpose.

ADJUSTMENTS:

The amount computed at the above Monthly Rate shall be adjusted plus or minus by an amount calculated in accordance with the formula specified in the Utilities' Power Cost Adjustment Clause which is incorporated by reference as a part of this rate schedule.

Second- Plus the applicable proportionate part of any directly allocable tax, impost or assessment imposed or levied by any governmental authority, which is assessed or levied against the Utilities or directly affects the Utilities' cost of operation and which the Utilities is legally obligated to pay on the basis of meter, customers, or rates of, or revenue from electric power and energy or service sold, or on the volume of the energy generated, transported, purchased for sale, or sold, or on any other basis where direct allocation is possible.

PAYMENT:

Bills are due and payable each month upon presentation. If a bill is not paid within fifteen days from the date thereof, Utilities have the right to suspend service.

RESERVATION:

The Greenwood Utilities Commission reserves the right to change this rate at any time it may deem necessary, and service is subject to compliance with Service Rules and Regulations and other Utilities' policies as are applicable.
